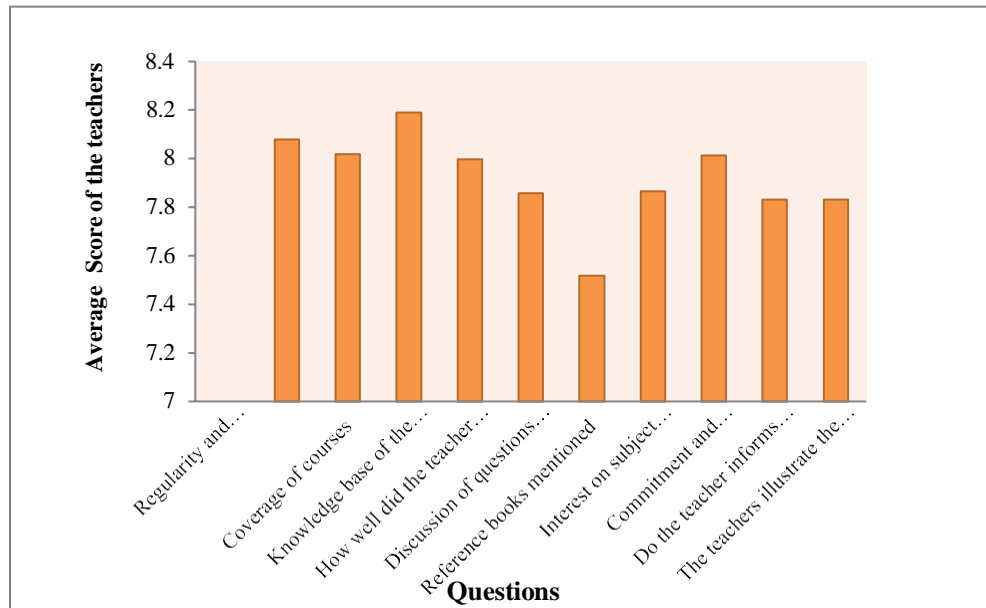


# **Feedback Analysis Report**

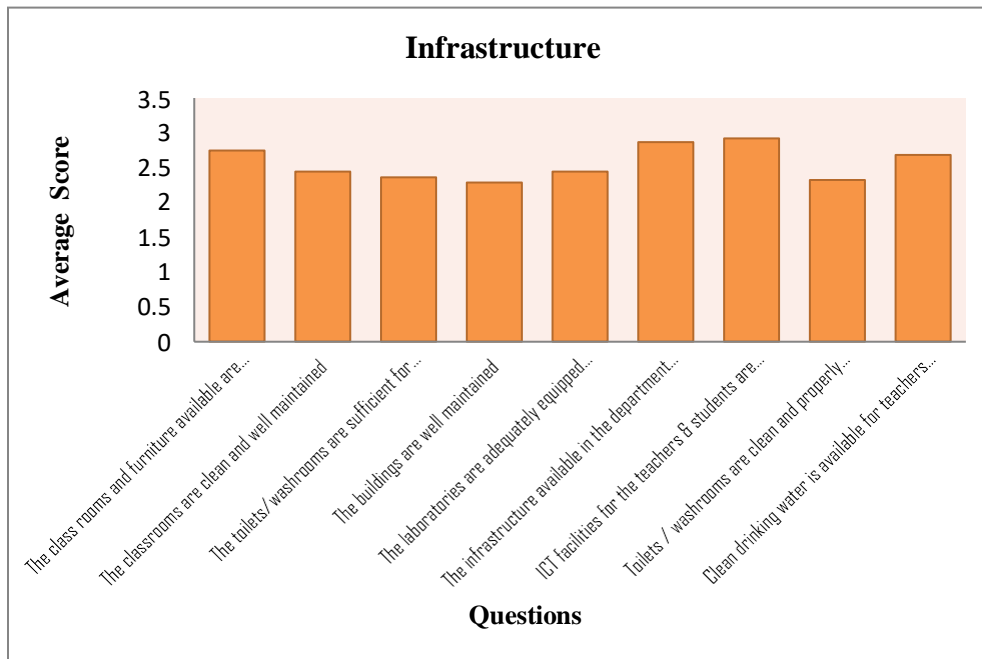
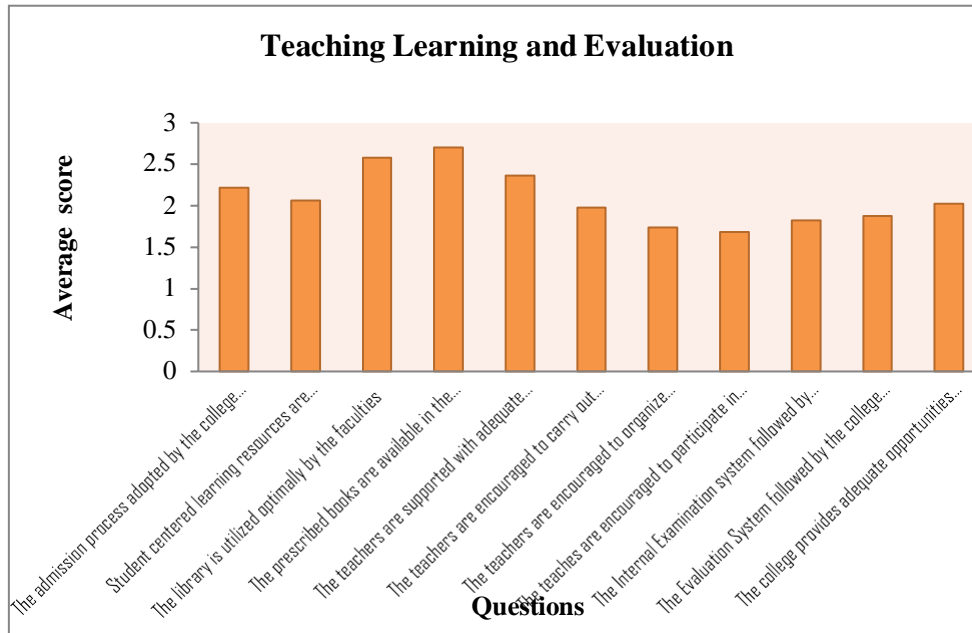
## **1. Feedback on teachers by the students:**



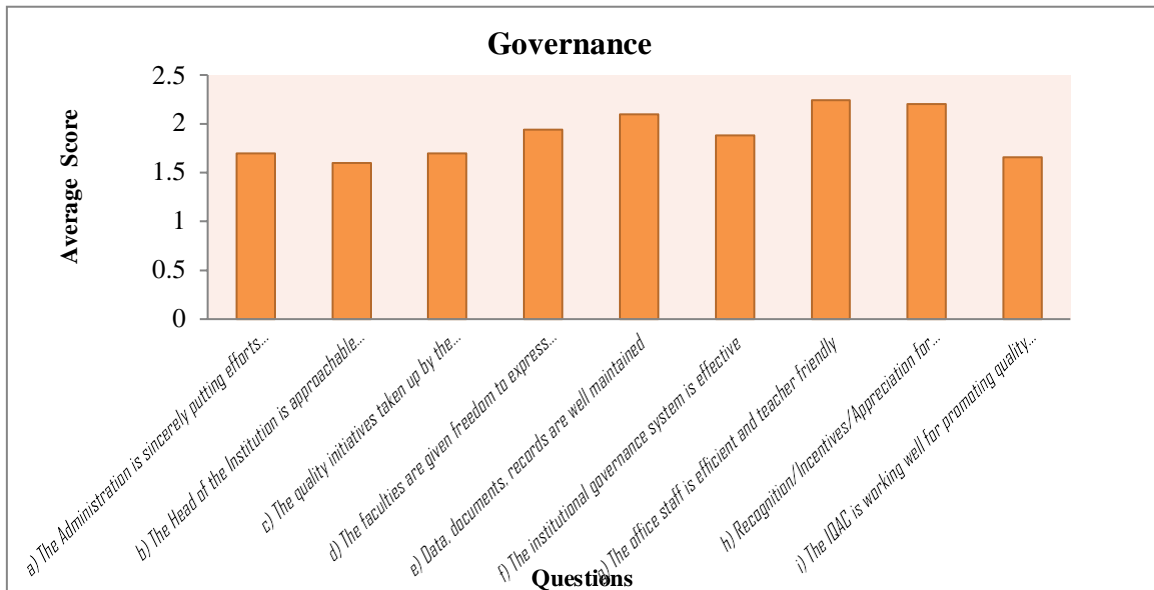
The feedback of the teachers from the students has been taken from all the departments in the college. The responses of the students regarding performance of the teachers that were asked is found to be quite satisfactory. The above graph represents the average score of the teachers based on 11 questions asked to the students. It is noted from the graph that the students rated highest score to question 3 which is about the knowledge based for the teachers followed by question 1 (regularity and punctuality of the teacher) and question 2 (coverage of the courses) . On the other hand, a very less score was given to question 6 which is about the reference books that were mentioned by the teachers in the class. This reflects that the students express the need of more reference books to be introduced in the class.

2. Feedback from the teachers:



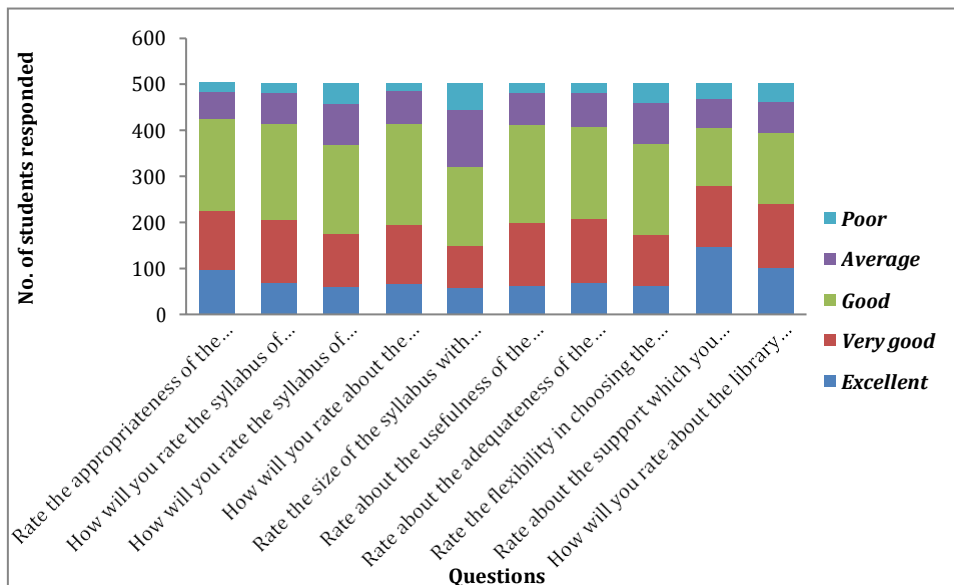

The feedback report received from the teachers about the institution on different aspects viz., teaching learning and evaluation, library, infrastructure, ICT facilities, administration etc., is found to be quite satisfactory. **Students' Feedback Report on Curriculum**  
**Session: 2021-2022**

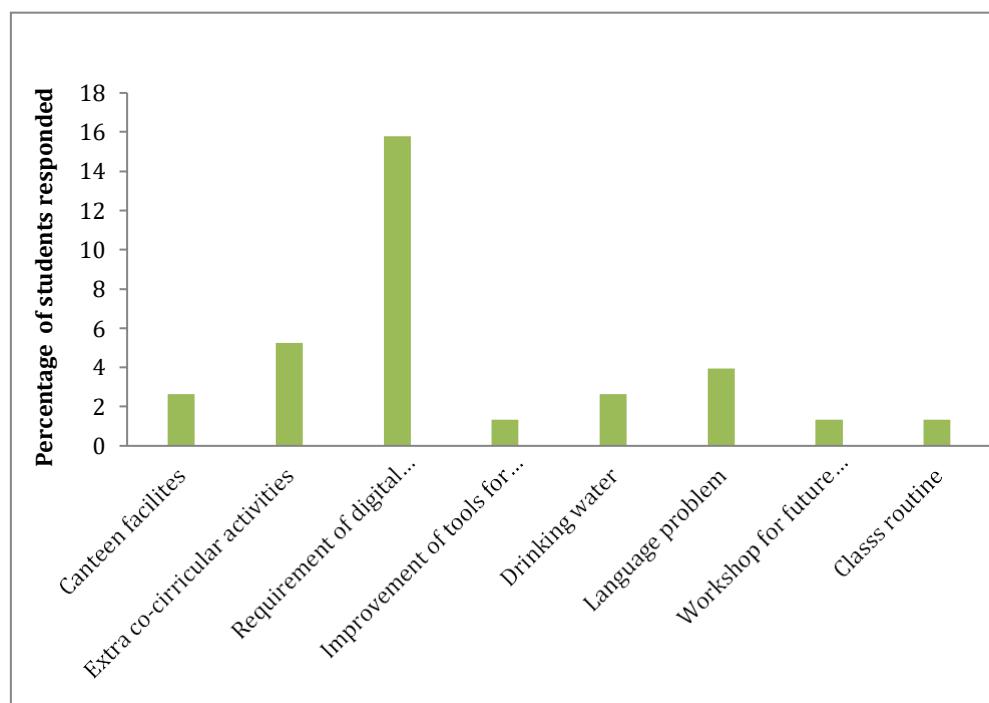


The feedback from the students is one of the important factors for the enhancement of the learning environment. The student's feedback will also help the teachers to boost their skills. For the session 2022, a feedback on curriculum from the students of all the departments was collected in an online mode. For this, a Google form was created. The Google form consisted of 10 questions related to curriculum. We have received a total of 503 responses from the students. From the student's survey report, it is found that 98 percent of the students have rated excellent and nearly 4 percent have rated poor about the appropriateness of the course provided in their curriculum. It has also been observed from the graph that more than 43 percent of the students are satisfied with the usefulness of their courses with respect to analytical abilities. Further, it is also noted from the student's responses that 28 percent of the students from the various departments have rated very good when asked about the library facilities of the institution. Furthermore, out of 503 responses, nearly 2 percent of the students have expressed the need for better extra-curricular activities.

## Students' Feedback Analysis Report

The above graph represents the suggestion of the students about the overall environment of the institution. The feedback from the students has been taken from all the departments in the college. From the students survey it is found that out of 152 student's responses, nearly 3 percent of the students have a complaint regarding canteen facilities. About 5 percent of the students are not satisfied with extra-curricular activities in the college. It is noted from the above graph that nearly 16 percent of the students have shared that they will be happy if the classes will be taken digitally along with the conventional method. Nearly 2 percent of the students are not satisfied with class routine and availability of the instruments for the practical subject provided in the institution. About 3 percent of the students are dissatisfied with the drinking water facility in the institution. On the other hand, out of 152 responses nearly 4 percent of the students have expressed that they are facing difficulties in understanding the language of the teacher while 2 percent of the students have suggested for conduction of workshops to a greater extent for their future competitive exams.
